Reduced Crowd is a Government Regulation

STORES ARE GOING TO HAVE FEWER PEOPLE INSIDE

The new executive order limits the number of people allowed inside stores at one time, which means fewer people crowding the aisles, but also, if you go at a busy time, you may have to wait in line outside.

<u>Some stores were already doing this</u> — Target, Trader Joe's, Wegmans and Harris Teeter were already placing limits on occupancy. But now there are concrete rules requiring the metering of occupants and guidelines for how occupancy must be calculated.

• The new executive order dictates that stores are limited to 20% of the stated fire capacity, or they can have 5 persons per 1,000 square feet. This is called Emergency Maximum Occupancy.

• Stores must have personnel at the door to limit access once the store has Emergency Maximum Occupancy.

• When Emergency Maximum Occupancy is reached and people are lined up outside stores, the store must clearly mark lines six feet apart where people can stand while waiting.

ONCE YOU'RE INSIDE, STAY FAR APART

The CDC has repeatedly said the best way to slow the spread of COVID-19 is to maintain a distance from others. If you must go out, stay six feet apart from other people.

But anyone who has been inside a store lately knows that not everyone follows that rule. (Note: Experts say it's <u>OK to quickly pass others in an aisle</u>, but you should not linger near other shoppers or workers, contemplating which cut of meat looks better. Likewise, if someone is looking at the chicken, stand back and let them finish before crowding in.)

SINGAPORE - From spaced-out queues to enter malls to the use of alternate stools at hawker centres, safe distancing was largely in place across the island on Friday (March 27), as strict new regulations kicked in to limit crowds and minimise close contact in public areas.

The temporary closure of entertainment venues did little to deter Singaporeans from venturing out, with healthy crowds observed at malls, hawker centres and supermarkets.

Crowd control measures were in full force at several malls The Straits Times visited, with most sealing the majority of their entrances, including underpasses to MRT stations and other buildings, to control traffic flow.

Starting Friday, malls, attractions and other public venues have had to limit their capacity and <u>disperse groups of more than 10</u> or face penalties if they are found to have been a place of transmission for Covid-19.

Those who intentionally sit less than Im away from another person in a public place or on a fixed seat marked as not to be occupied or who stand in a queue less than the same distance away from another person will now also be guilty of an offence.

If convicted, they can be fined up to \$10,000, jailed for up to six months, or both, under










Wider Door






What if the door width is wider than the FOV of single counting camera?




What if the door width is wider than the FOV of single counting camera?










Occupancy Mode


